Case Study:	PACT: Helping Companies Assess Their Strategic Exposure To Climate Risks	
Description:	<p>Summary: The developers of PACT apply this tool to help companies assess their strategic exposure to climate change, analyzing how resilient or vulnerable they are and identifying possible projects which offer win-win outcomes and accelerated strategic learning so as to build a routemap towards sharp strategies for change. The tool uses nine 'complementary areas' or 'pathways' to measure organizational change in terms of 'response levels' or scales that an organization can achieve.</p>  <p style="text-align: right;">Placemark Link</p> <p>More information: Applying the PACT process typically takes a couple of days on site plus an analysis of documents and communications. During the process, interviews are conducted with key personnel to identify the business issues and gather evidence on where the company stands and the capacity to evolve along the nine pathways. For example, within the UK, PACT has helped construction companies identify:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) What level of performance they need to attain to take into account possible climate risks; (2) Pinpoint where they currently stand; (3) And map out the practical actions that can help them address extreme events such as flooding or heavy rains. <p>At the core of this approach is the strategic capacity building that offers a unique insight into the main issues, opportunities and risks presented by climate change and a framework to help shape sustained changes in organisational and individual behaviour.</p>	
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
