- Following the model of AG8: integration of knowledge linking natural hazard management and climate adaptation to strengthen synergies
 - → keeps work products alive, leverages dissemination of results, and increases their transnational impacts
 - allows entire Alpine community to benefit from transnational knowledge sharing
 - → supports strategic policy areas and cross-sectoral implementation initiatives of EUSALP
