## Thematic Working Group on Knowledge Platforms

The EU Mission on Adaptation to Climate Change, through its platform MIP4Adapt, seeks to support and accompany at least 150 European regions and communities toward climate resilience by 2030. Thus, fostering collaboration and knowledge exchange within the Mission's Community of Practice.

Given the ongoing expansion of online information platforms, there's a need for better coordination and context regarding accurate data transmission, particularly concerning climate change risks and adaptation. Knowledge is often fragmented and siloed leading to redundancy and/or replication, or worse, it can lead to users being misinformed or unsure of what to use.

MAIA is exploring the possibility of establishing a Cluster Group on this topic. The Group would comprise representatives of climate research projects and initiatives beyond Europe and selected counterparts from European projects.

The intention is to provide a new space for open exchange and friendly interaction to uncover opportunities for learning and exchange. Particularly on how certain climate research and policy aspects might be perceived, handled, and/or prioritised differently in other regions of the world.
